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
Report on Anti-Ragging Day Celebration

Drawing competition:




Slogan writing competition:


Essay writing competition:


• Pledge/Oath for a Ragging-Free Campus:

The documentary short film is shown to all the participants.




Attendance:


- All the students of the institute from various department participated in the different types of activities.
